

**MINUTES
OF THE
LA PAZ COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
Monday, March 5, 2018, at 11:00 a.m.
Worksession**

Chairman Wilson called the March 5, 2018, worksession of the La Paz County Board of Supervisors to order at 11:12 a.m. Elected Officials and Department Heads present were: Chairman Wilson, Supervisor Minor, Supervisor Irwin, (County Administrator Drake was on annual leave), Human Resource Director Frantz, Finance Director Krukemyer, Treasurer Castro, Superior Court Clerk Spielman, Elections Director Scholl; and Deputy Clerk of the Board Green.

Discussion regarding the New County Website

Chairman Wilson discussed the issues with the current website, in addition to not being ADA (American with Disabilities) compliant. He noted that work was initiated in July 2017 by a group of employees that “stepped up” to do so.

He stated there were plans to initiate people in each department to keep up with the changes to will occur to alleviate the work from a few; and discussed all that had been accomplished so far.

He stated that input had been requested by several sources and acknowledge that there were concerns that just the Parker area was represented; however, he had implemented other pictures and asked for further input.

Supervisor Irwin reiterated that the most common complaint of the old website was there was no representation of other areas/taxpayers.

Chairman Wilson stated that if anyone had anything they wanted to add, the contacts have been provided. He added that the Fiduciary contacted the team, and that department was added the same day, noting the capability of the “team”.

Supervisor Minor stated he has asked for photos from the Bouse and Quartzsite area and was waiting for those.

Chairman Wilson stated that he is looking forward to going online with the new website; gave “kudos” to the website team; noting an approximate “live” date as Friday, March 9.

Chairman Wilson adjourned the meeting at 11:24 a.m.
