

**MINUTES  
OF THE  
LA PAZ COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS  
Wednesday, March 7, 2018, 10:00 a.m.  
Worksession**

Chairman Wilson called the March 7, 2018, worksession of the La Paz County Board of Supervisors to order at 10:00 a.m. Elected Officials and Department Heads present were: Chairman Wilson, Supervisor Minor, (Supervisor Irwin was not present), County Administrator Drake, Assessor Camacho, Community Resource Director McFarland, Human Resource Director Frantz, Recorder Baker, Finance Director Krukemyer; and Deputy Clerk of the Board Green.

**Konica Minolta (KM) IT Services Presentation – John Petersen, CHP**

Chairman Wilson introduced John Petersen and Ken Niziolek, representatives of Konica Minolta ad All Covered, a subsidiary of Konica Minolta.

Mr. Petersen gave a power point presentation on the IT services portion of the Konico Minolta, called All Covered. He explained at length the services provided in a “24-7” service contract, detailing the security and management aspects of the services, adding that the County already had a six-year relationship with them.

He gave a history of All Covered, forming in 1977, with six data centers over the continent; and explained in detail their management approach. He stated that an inventory of all the County’s systems and networks would be assessed up front without the usual \$10,000 charge, in “good faith” of the current relationship with the County.

Supervisor Minor asked what would “trigger” additional fees to their services.

Mr. Petersen answered that adding new networks or setting up additional computers for personnel would warrant a fee.

Discussion ensued on the different systems the County deals with, which would be included in the primary assessment; and a “snapshot” was given as to what was involved in the assessment, as well as an overview upon completion of the assessment.

Mr. Peter stated that the assessment could take over 45 days; however, to initiate the assessment would be quickly at approximately three days.

There being no further business to discuss, Chairman Wilson adjourned the worksession at 11:01 a.m.
