

**MINUTES

Worksession**

Chairman Wilson called the March 19, 2018, worksession of the La Paz County Board of Supervisors to order at 1:03 p.m. Elected Officials and Department Heads present were: Chairman Wilson, Supervisor Minor, Supervisor Irwin, and Executive Assistant Reeves.

Presentation by EagleView on Pictometry Intelligent Images: aerial imagery, data analytics, property data, and GIS solutions for local and federal government agencies

Chairman Wilson called upon Program Specialist Rohde to introduce those present giving the presentation.

Program Specialist Rohde introduced Brian Garcia, representing Eagle View, to give a presentation on their technology. She stated that two Assessors from other Counties, from Mohave and Yuma County, were also present and have utilized this technology.

Mr. Garcia gave an overview of the Eagle View company and discussed what value their technology had in the way of assisting assessments through pictometry.

He discussed at length the benefits the technology brought to counties and other entities, saving both time and money, “doing more with less”.

Joe Wehrle, Yuma County Assessor, and Jeannie Kentch, Mohave County Assessor, commented on their experiences, and how they were progressing with the system.

He gave a software demonstration that showed the information that could be received through a desktop to be able to make decisions that currently require sending staff out into the field.

There being no further business to discuss, Chairman Wilson adjourned the worksession.
