

PARTISAN, NON-PARTISAN, & OTHER THAN PRIMARY CANDIDATE CHECK LIST CAMPAIGN FINANCE DATES

A.R.S. 16-905: A candidate that receives contributions and makes expenditures, in any combination, of at least \$1200 in connection with his/her candidacy must file a Statement of Organization with the County Elections Department.

From the day you meet the \$1200, you have 10 days to file a Statement of Organization.

If you do not plan to receive contributions and make expenditures, in any combination, of at least \$1200, you DO NOT NEED to file a Statement of Organization.

PRIMARY ELECTION August 4, 2020

GENERAL ELECTION November 3, 2020

FORMS LISTED BELOW MUST BE FILED TOGETHER, IN ORIGINALS, WITH THE ELECTION DEPT.

NOMINATION PAPER, AFFIDAVIT OF QUALIFICATION, & CAMPAIGN FINANCE LAWS STATEMENT

(all three of these are on the same one page form)

- () Make sure to answer every question and fill in every blank.
- () Print the candidate's name exactly how he or she wants it to appear on the ballot. The candidates last name must appear first. Nicknames are permissible as long as they do not suggest a title.
- () The candidate must sign the form and have the signature notarized.

FINANCIAL DISCLOSURE STATEMENT

- () Covers preceding 12-month period preceding the filing (this is a different time period from Public Officer filing in January)
- () Make sure to answer every question and fill in every blank.
- () The candidate must sign the form
- () **Financial Disclosure Statement does not apply to Title 48 Special Taxing District, Community College Board Members, Justice of the Peace or Precinct Committeeman positions**

NOMINATION PETITIONS

(each Circulator must be responsible for witnessing ALL the signatures on the petitions that they circulate
(A.R.S 16-321))

- () The candidate must file **AT LEAST THE MINIMUM NUMBER OF SIGNATURES** required for the office sought, but no more than the maximum number, for the Elections Director to accept the nomination papers.
- () Check to see that the circulator portion of each petition is complete
- () Before circulating any nomination petition, make sure that all spaces at the top of the petition are completed.

OVER

- () Check to see that the signature portion of each petition is complete:
 - Is there a signature for each signer
 - Is there a printed name for each signature
 - Is their actual residence address printed or description of place of residence: Arizona Post Office box, address, city or town.
 - Is there a date for each signature

- () Check to see that the circulator portion on the back of each petition is complete. Did the Circulator:
 - **Print** his/her name in space provided
 - Print the County in the space provided
 - **Sign** his/her name in the space provided
 - Print the circulator's **actual residence address including city, town, and zip code**

CANDIDATES THAT FILED A STATEMENT OF ORGANIZATION MUST:

- () File a Campaign Finance Report with the Elections Department
- () File a Termination Statement after election is over

CANDIDATE COMMITTEES THAT **DID NOT** file a Statement of Organization, do not need to file a Termination Statement after the election.
