

**MINUTES
OF THE
LA PAZ COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
Thursday, August 25, 2016, 9:30 a.m.
Special Meeting**

Vice-Chairman Wilson called the August 25, 2016, special meeting of the La Paz County Board of Supervisors to order at 9:30 a.m. Elected Officials and Department Heads present were: Chairman Irwin (telephonically), Vice-Chairman Wilson, Supervisor Clapperton, Finance Director Mancuso; and Deputy Clerk of the Board Green.

Approve revision #2 of the FY 2016/2017 Tax Levies – Finance

Finance Director Mancuso presented a request for a second revision of the FY 2016/2017 Tax Levies. He explained that, after input from the fire districts, errors were found in calculation of some of the numbers, and were changed for the better.

He explained that the revision dealt specifically with the Buckskin Fire District, lowering their budget amount from \$1,880,036 to \$1,803,929. He stated that the direct property tax levy then changed from 3.2074 to 3.0776.

He added that correcting these numbers consequently changed the direct property tax levies for the Fire District Assistance Fund Tax, which was separated with its own line item, affecting the distribution of all the fire districts on this fund.

Supervisor Clapperton asked for a definition of the Fire District Assistance Fund Tax (FDAT).

Finance Director Mancuso explained that the FDAT was a secondary tax specifically to aid fire districts, which is distributed to the fire districts each quarter year. He reiterated that it was the distribution of these funds that had changed as a result; and no change to the tax rate for the other fire districts.

VICE-CHAIRMAN WILSON MOVED to approve revision #2 of the FY 2016/2017 Tax Levies. Motion seconded by Supervisor Clapperton, passed unanimously.
