

## DRIVING WITHOUT INSURANCE INFORMATION

### IMPORTANT NOTICE

If you have been cited for violation of any of the following Statutes [ARS §§28-4135A; 28-4135B; 28-4135C] regarding mandatory insurance, then it is imperative that you read and follow the instructions listed below.

The Arizona State Legislature has enacted legislation which provides for a **mandatory minimum sanction** (fine) of \$972.00 for a first offense, a three month suspension of your driving privileges, plates and registration of the vehicle. Additionally, if you fail to appear or pay the sanctions due or submit proof as indicated below **by the appearance date on your citation**, a suspension fee of \$50.00 will be added to the total due along with a \$20.00 late fee and your case will be submitted to a collection agency who will add an initial fee of \$35.00, plus an additional 19% of the total.

If you had valid insurance at the time you were stopped, you are required to submit **a copy of your current MVD Driver Report for the past 36 months and a letter from your insurance company or agent on company letterhead**. The letter must provide the following information:

Company's name, address and telephone number +

1. Description of the vehicle – Make, Model, Year, Vehicle Identification Number
2. Policy Number
3. Effective (inception ) & expiration date
4. Letter must be signed by an agent or company representative
5. Statement coverage was in effect on the date of the citation.
6. Option 1 completed

**THE JUDGE WILL NOT ACCEPT ANY OTHER FORM OF PROOF OTHER THAN THE LETTER AS STATED ABOVE. DO NOT SEND A COPY OF THE INSURANCE ID CARD. OR DECLARATIONS, IT WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.**

If you did not have insurance at the time of the stop, but can show proof (as stated above) that you have purchased at least six consecutive months of insurance, the Judge may reduce the sanction to \$315.00.

**IT IS IMPERATIVE THAT YOU SUBMIT PROOF AND/OR PAYMENT TO THE COURT ON OR BEFORE THE APPEARANCE DATE AT THE BOTTOM OF THE CITATION EITHER IN PERSON OR BY MAIL.**

*TO ENSURE THE MATTER DOES NOT GO INTO DEFAULT, YOU MUST CALL THE COURT 5-7 DAYS AFTER MAILING YOUR DOCUMENTS, TO ENSURE THAT WE RECEIVED THEM.*

Effective 01/01/2012

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If you did not have insurance at the time of the stop, but can show proof (as stated above) that you have purchased at least six consecutive months of insurance, the Judge may reduce the sanction to \$328.00.

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
